Pilgrimage Church in Mariastein

15 km north-west of the Hohe Salve, at 575 m above sea level, lies one of the most famous places of pilgrimage in the country: Mariastein. The snow-white pilgrimage church is impressively situated on a 14 m high rock. The church was built around 1360 and was raised to the status of a pilgrimage church in the 18th century after a miracle of the Virgin Mary. It has been a popular pilgrimage site since the late Middle Ages.
