

First bell founders' exhibition opened in the Pillerseetal

(Waidring) Shouting, listening, celebrating, casting - these are the topics of the new bell founders' exhibition, which opens its doors in Waidring with immediate effect. The 360° tour is multimedia-based and enables visitors to experience the traditional craft all year round. You will learn how bells served as an alternative smoke signal, what role bells played in the world wars and what is important in casting. Films, sounds, display boards, photos and various exhibits make the tour an experience for the whole family and underline the uniqueness of the village of Waidring. Highlight is the show casting in one of the last three art and bell foundries in Austria. Adults pay five euros for the exhibition, with the PillerseeTal guest card only four. Children up to six are free of charge, for all older people the entrance fee is three euros. The show casting is to be paid directly to Wolfgang Olivier and costs 3 Euros, for all children under eight years it costs nothing.

The bell-founders' exhibition can be visited on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 13 to 17 hrs.

In summer 2020 the bell adventure trail will be opened. On a tour through the village all interesting anecdotes of the Waidringer bell history will be told. The end point of the adventure path is a large carillon with 12 sounding bodies. Here the "Waidring song" plays, which was composed especially for the bell village. glockendorf.tirol

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
